

Village of Plain Special Village Board Meeting May 2, 2023

A Special Meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Plain was held at the Plain Municipal Office, located at 510 Main Street, on May 2, 2023. The meeting was called to order by Administrator/Clerk/Treasurer Sheila Carver at 6:15 p.m.

The following members were present: Terry Drone; Wade Neubauer; Merry Lynn Riek; Steve Whitford; and, Kelly Yanke, Trustees. Trustee Melissa Marx attended via Zoom.

Others present: Ray Ring attended as a member of the public and not in his official capacity as Village President due to a conflict of interest.

The purpose of this meeting was to approve an original liquor license application for David J. Moreno located at 1150/1170 Main Street expiring June 30, 2023.

Carver asked for a motion to elect a Chair for the meeting. Marx motioned to elect Riek as chair. Yanke seconded. Motion carried.

David J. Moreno has applied for a Class "B" fermented malt beverages and "Class B" intoxicating liquor license. Carver contacted the Wisconsin Department of Revenue Alcohol & Tobacco Enforcement division for their opinion on a felony on David's record. It was a party to arson from 31 years ago. Arson is not on the Department's list of felonies that may result in refusal and it was a long time ago. They said it is up to the discretion of the board but they do not object to the approval of this license.

Janet Haight, Agent for the liquor license for Roarin 20s LLC, has signed off to surrender "Class B" intoxicating liquor license for the proposed premises, which is limited by the state.

Marx motioned to approve the liquor license, Class "B" fermented malt beverages and "Class B" intoxicating liquor, for David J. Moreno, Trade Name: Lone Rockers, LLC, 1150/1170 Main Street, for the period May 3, 2023 through June 30, 2023. Whitford seconded. Motion carried.

Yanke motioned to adjourn at 6:20 p.m. Whitford seconded. Motion carried.
