Village Board Proceedings of December 4, 2019
2020 Budget Hearing & Special Meeting

A Public Hearing was held in the Village of Plain at the Plain Municipal Office Building on December 4, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was to review the proposed 2020 budgets.

Roll Call: Ray Ring, Village President; Brian Brey; John Dischler; Andrew Kraemer; Melissa Marx; Merry Lynn Riek; and, Steve Whitford, Trustees.

Notice of this meeting was posted on November 13, 2019 in the following locations in the Village of Plain: Municipal Office Building; Plain Post Office; and, The Peoples Community Bank. The preliminary budget summary was published in the November 13, 2019 issue of the Home News.

The hearing was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President Ray Ring.

After review of the information and budgets presented, Marx motioned to adjourn the Public Hearing at 7:01 p.m. Whitford seconded. Motion carried.

The Special Meeting of the Board of Trustees to approve 2020 budgets presented was called to order immediately following the Budget Public Hearing at 7:01 p.m. by President Ray Ring.

Budget Approvals

Brey motioned to adopt the General Fund budget of \$683,981.27 as presented. Riek seconded. Motion carried.

Brey motioned to adopt the Debt Services Fund Budget of \$135,598.42 as presented. Dischler seconded. Motion carried.

Brey motioned to adopt the T.I.F. District Fund Budget of \$145,002.52 as presented. Dischler seconded. Motion carried.

Brey motioned to adopt the Capital Improvements Fund Budget of \$38,656.80 as presented. Riek seconded. Motion carried.

Riek motioned to adopt the Golf Course Budget of \$45,000.00 as presented. Marx seconded. Motion carried.

Brey motioned to approve the Village tax levy of \$666,202.00. Kraemer seconded. Motion carried.

Brey motioned to set the effective payroll date for 2020 wages for Village employees as January 6, 2020. Marx seconded. Motion carried.
